

## Ticket Policies

Everyone must have a ticket, including children 6 and older. Please note that our concerts are not open to infants and children under 6, except for the family holiday concert.

Student and group discounts are available when you order by phone or in person. Single tickets at \$10 are available to students between ages 6-18 and college students with a valid statement or ID. Groups of 10 or more receive discounts of 10% per individual concert ticket in any price category. Ask about these discounts when you call for your tickets.

We have accessible seating at all of our concert venues. Please make your disability-related needs known when you order tickets.

Tickets may be exchanged up to 3 days before a concert. Physical tickets must be presented at the Choral Arts Ensemble office to make the exchange.

Sorry, no refunds can be given; however, you will be sent a receipt for your tax-deductible contribution.

Latecomers will be seated at appropriate pauses in the concert according to the conductor's wishes. Please plan plenty of time for locating the concert venue and parking. Better yet, allow an extra half hour and join us for the pre-concert lecture with the composers and artists.
